## **T.A.R.A. Business Meeting Tuesday, 09 January, 1996**

The meeting was called to order at 1931 hrs EST by president Jeff Stewart, KF9UP.

### Reports

The minutes from the previous meeting were approved as published.

Treasurer Jack Freeman, KF9CT, reported a balance of \$14,014.17 for all club accounts. A complete report will appear in the next edition of the *Tattler*. He also reported that the State has reinstated the club's not-for-profit status.

### Old Business

KF9UP announced that the January program meeting, the annual banquet, would be held at the Sirloin Stockade, 4023 State Road 26 East, on January 24 at 7:30 pm. Those arriving early should wait in the banquet room until 7:30, and the group will go through the serving line together. Dutch Treat. Spouses and guests are welcome.

### New Business

KF9UP asked, with the impending change in club treasurer, for volunteers to review the club books. Bruce Stewart, N9GKE, and Bob Finch, N6CXB, will perform this service.

N9GKE announced that Sam Brummet, N9XPZ, was interested in operating the VHF Sweepstakes the weekend of January 20-21. Bob Martin, W7YE, noted that the club station may not be available during the afternoon of 1/20 due to the previously schedule VE session. It was also pointed out that operation could not take place prior to noon on Sunday due to interference to the PA system at the Unitarian Church. Nick Miller, KB9BZV, noted that the Purdue Amateur Club, W9YB, planed to operate this contest and that TARA members were welcome to join them.

The floor was opened for nominations for club officers. Club members nominated at the December meeting include W7YE for president, Curtis Sherwin, WB9SWD for vice president, WA9TGO for treasurer, and Tim Gennett, KF9WX for secretary. Ed Delp, N9YTE, moved that nominations be closed. The motion was seconded and passed. W7YE made a few remarks about his agenda should he be elected as president and a brief discussion ensued. It was then moved and seconded that the above mentioned candidates be elected by unanimous consent. The motion passed.

Dan Porat, N9VFE, was present and introduced as a guest. It was moved and seconded that he be accepted as a club member. The motion passed.

### Announcements

W7YE announced that the VE session would be at 1330 hrs on 1/20 at the Red Cross Chapter House.

W7YE also recommend that the club secretary send a letter of thanks to J. B. Van Sickle, K9KRE, in appreciation of his outstanding service as editor of the *Tattler*. This recommendation was adopted by consent.

N6CXB announced that a Heathkit 200 linear amplifier had been donated to the club. He will inspect and test.

Jim Canarecci, WA9TGO, inquired about the status of repairs to the club generator. KF9CT and N9GKE reported that there was no change from last month's report.

The attendance drawing was held for the \$6.00 prize. N9YAW's name was drawn. As he was not in attendance the February drawing will be for \$12.00.

There being no other business, WA9TGO moved that the meeting be adjourned. The motion was seconded and passed. The meeting adjourned at 1957 hrs EST.

**Club Meetings and Members**

We currently have 97 members of the club. Not an all time high, but close to it.

Of those 97, 62 have been to at least one meeting during the past year. I will admit that if you have been attending meetings, that may seem high, but that is what the attendance report indicate.

When you consider where several of our members live, plus some others that belong so that they can receive the 'Tattler', and that others have work schedules that conflict, maybe that figure is reasonable.

Average attendance, however, was 20.4 per meeting, including non-members, from a high of 29 to a nadir of 16, bringing member attendance to less than 20%, a figure that is still probably respectful.

Several years back (and there are several current members who can remember this era), the club would go several meetings in a row with-out having enough members in attendance to constitute a quorum, and not legally able to carry on the business of the club.

It was at this time that it was decided to conduct business at the Tuesday meeting, and have the Wednesday meeting as a Program Night (with only emergency business being conducted).

This was also the re-start of the 'Tattler' (it had been published about 20 years earlier) to publicize the 'program' and build attendance. It worked. To make it work the 'Tattler' needs timely notification of the subject matter so we can entice that other 80% of the club. If you have ideas for a program, let President, or the Program Committee hear from you.
