TARA Business Meeting Minutes -- 8/8/00

Major Sherwin N9ZFG gave the Treasurer's report and received one question about how Field Day donations were shown. Major explained all Field Day donations made the night of the auction were lumped together as one donation in the June report. Major also reported that the county auditor has renewed our tax exempt status.

Old Business

- The MFJ antenna analyzer still needs to be permanently repaired. It is usable, however.
- Steve Van Frank W9TN suggested a day for the rekeying of the station door and the meeting room door. Wednesday 8/23 seems to be a good choice as members will be present that night for the program meeting and will be able to swap keys. Those present agreed, and Steve will schedule the rekeying for that day and put an announcement in the newsletter. The procedure to obtain a new key remains the same. Talk to a club officer and the officer will request a key and alarm code which you then may pick up from the Red Cross.
- Bruce Stewart reviewed the upcoming program meetings. We will have the presentation by J. B. Van Sickle K9KRE on 8/23 concerning standing motions and other club business. The next program meeting will be on 9/27 and will be a presentation by Bob Lagrange from state emergency management concerning the statewide 800 MHz trunked radio system. Ed Delp N9YTE will give us a presentation on GPS for the 10/25 program meeting.

New Business

- Jeff Stewart KF9UP announced that he has been asked for communications support by the Wabash Valley Cycle Club for their event to benefit Family Services, Inc. The event consists of multiple bicycle races up to 100 miles long to be run on Sunday 8/27. Multiple remote portable stations will probably be required, and Jeff will be finding out more details soon. Contact Jeff if you are interested in helping out.
- Marty Mlynarik K9ICQ was admitted as a new member (not present at the meeting) on a motion by Ed Delp seconded by Tim Gardner N9LF. Marty is an active local ham. Welcome, Marty!
- Dan Sapir was also admitted as a new member on a motion by Tim Gardner seconded by Ed Delp. Dan is new to ham radio, and will be taking his license test at our hamfest test session. Welcome Dan, and good luck on your test!

Hamfest Report

Dave Dull WB9BRX reported on preparations for our hamfest. Everything is going well. Jeff Stewart is going to arrange for tables, and several members are going to help move items from storage to the site. Tim Gardner is going to run the talk-in station, and Major Sherwin is in charge of food. Dave has lined up some good prizes including an MFJ antenna analyzer, several books, a clock, and a tool kit. Steve Van Frank passed along a prize donated by Steve Belter N9IP. It is a low power FM transmitter kit with enclosure.

Antenna Committee Report

Jeff Stewart reported he has looked at the antennas and the crossarm and has determined what hardware we need. He will obtain the hardware and suggested we have an antenna party on Saturday 8/12 at 9am. Several members present agreed to be there to help.

Jim Davis WA9LYC won the drawing, but was not present to collect his winnings. Ed Delp moved to adjourn and Tim Gardner seconded and the meeting adjourned at 8:24pm.

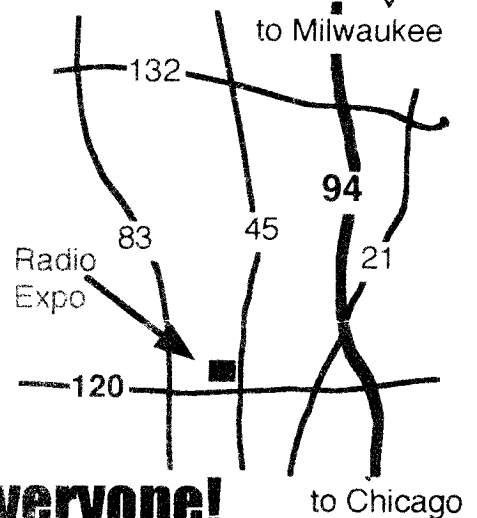
