President Jim Darling called the meeting to order at 7:34pm.

Corrections to last month's minutes. Dave Dull's call sign is WB9BRX. Dave has two cats, only one of which is female.

Treasurer's report given by Dave Dull. Total income was \$141.93. Total disbursements were \$550.32. Beginning assets were \$9476.70. Ending assets were \$9068.31.

Old Business:

There has been some suggestion that J.B. VanSickle, K9KRE, would like to have someone else takeover responsibilities for the TARA Tattler. John Martin, KB9OQC, has expressed an interest in taking over the duties.

There were four license upgrades at the last testing session on Jan.19th. I'm sorry, I missed who they were (update next month?).

New Business:

We received an application for membership from Daniel L. McDaniel (no call). His application was printed from the website. He wrote that he would like some help obtaining his license and setting up a station. If anyone is interested in helping Mr. McDaniel his phone number is 474-7759, and his e-mail address is USSMcDaniel@AOL.com. Since his application contained \$6 Bruce Stewart motioned to accept the membership with Major Sherwin seconding. The motion was passed.

President Jim has heard of some interest in Morse Code classes. He knows of at least six people who are interested in attending. Steve VanFrank said he was interested in teaching the class. Jim will make arrangements for possibly two nights a week at the Red Cross building and will make an announcement. Listen for him on Thursday night's net.

Last week Jim and I met with Debbie Elsner, the director of the Tippecanoe Red Cross. She expressed an interest in establishing a more familiar relationship with TARA especially in light of recent world events. One of her concerns was how to contact us in case of emergency. We told her to feel free to contact any of the officers. One of the reasons our club has space at the Red Cross is to provide emergency communications.

Brent Snellenbarger, WB9WOQ, donated some very nice equipment to the club. The list includes a TS-520, a Shure #444 mic, a Dentron Super Tuner, an AMECO dual LP code course, a Speedkey straight key, a Monarch code oscillator, and a Micronta field strength meter. As a side note: I spoke to Brent to thank him for the equipment. He told me that the 520 was a present from his parents when he graduated Purdue in 1977. He said the radio had served him well. Since moving into a new home his wife doesn't want any antennas around. Brent's hope was that this rig could help new hams get on the air possibly as a loner from the club. He holds an Extra class license and intends to remain on the air from his brother's home where obviously antenna restrictions are a little more relaxed. Thanks again Brent for the most generous donation.

Jeff Stewart's father-in-law passed away last month. He thanked the club for the planter that was sent.

This month's drawing was picked by Bruce Stewart, who of course wanted to keep drawing until he found his own name. While Bruce kept drawing Dave D. snatched the first name away revealing WE9Y Gary Reed to be the official pick this month. Since Gary was not present next month's prize will be \$18.

At this time there is no particular subject for this month's program meeting. President Jim suggests we get together to discuss subjects of interest for future meetings. Next month the National Weather Service should be having it's annual severe weather class. That could serve as our program meeting for March. Opinions and suggestions are welcome.

Motion to adjourn was made by Curtis Sherwin, seconded by Bruce Stewart. Meeting was adjourned at 8:07pm.
