New ARISS Antennas Installed on Columbus (Oct 23, 2007) -- Two Amateur Radio on the International Space Station (ARISS) antennas have been installed on the nadir side of the new International Space Station's Columbus module, set to launch later this year. On October 12, the antennas successfully passed electrical and SWR tests, with one of the two antennas, Antenna 42, going through a final test -- a thermal test under vacuum. Based on model-

ing, engineers have no fear the tenna will pass with flying col-Columbus will house an additional Amateur Radio station, cluding the first digital Amateur dio TV (DATV) station in space. well as a ham radio trans-



ponder. The yet-to-be-built Columbus amateur gear will facilitate operation on new frequencies that will make it possible for ARISS to establish wideband and video operations for the first time and allow continuous transponder operation. Video from the installation and inspection is available at the Columbus Web site.

ARRL On-Line Auction Preview Up and Running; Bidding Starts Wednesday (Oct 18, 2007) -- The Second Annual ARRL On-Line Auction went "almost live" this week



with more than 160 items to gawk at, gaze on and drool over. Bidding for these items, with more to be added as the auction progresses, will start Wednesday, October 24, with the final gavel sounding Friday, November 2. No bids can be placed during the preview week.

The K7RA Solar Update (Oct 19, 2007) -- Our Sun is still blank. The past week has shown no sunspots, and we will probably see more of nothing. Geomagnetic conditions have been very quiet, which means lower absorption of HF radio signals and lower noise. But this will



become more active in the near future due to a returning solar wind. Planetary A index for October 19-26 is predicted to be 15, 12, 8, 5, 8, 18, 20 and 25. Things should settle down during the CQ World Wide DX Phone Contest next weekend.

ARRL Continuing Education Course Registration (Oct 17, 2007) -- Registration remains open through Sunday, November 4 for these online courses beginning on Friday, November 16: Amateur Radio Emergency Communications Level 2 (EC-002); Amateur Radio Emergency Communications Level 3 (EC-003R2); Antenna Modeling (EC-004); HF Digital Communications (EC-005); VHF/UHF -- Life Beyond the Repeater (EC-008), and Radio Frequency Propagation (EC-011).

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New business:

In light of the Red Cross' refusal of the club's offer to purchase keys in advance, WB9BRX moved to make club members responsible for paying Red Cross for keys AB9LE seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

Tickets sold were \$1020 / \$5 = 204

Building rental was \$300 plus a \$300 refundable deposit (received)

Ticket printing was \$200, done 2007, allocated over 5 years at \$40 per year

Previous ticket printing was done in 2005, also \$200, of which only \$80 had been charged off. Since that is a sunk cost, it is of historical interest only, and does not result in a cash flow one way or the other.

On a cash flow basis, net income to the club was \$309 The \$309 also covers the 2005 ticket print expense of \$120, which results in net income to the club of \$169
